Photo 1 – From NE corner looking west at [REDACTED] Road frontage and northern boundary.



Photo 2 – From 15 feet north of NE corner looking south at corner (pink flagging), eastern boundary, and neighboring conservation land.



Photo 3 – From ~40 feet east of NE corner looking south at Lawrence Swamp Conservation Area/Robert Frost Trail sign on adjacent property.



Photo 4 –From an 18” plastic culvert ~230 ft west of NE corner looking south at intermittent stream and wetland from northern boundary.



Photo 5 – From another 18” plastic culvert located ~160 ft west of previous culvert looking south at another intermittent stream/wetland.



Photo 6 – From eastern edge of entrance to parcel looking at metal debris along side of road/northern boundary.



Photo 7 – From ~10 ft north of NW corner looking at corner, western boundary, and wetland.



Photo 8 – From ~10 west of NW corner looking east at corner, northern boundary, and [REDACTED] Road frontage.



Photo 9 – From ~75 ft southeast of NW corner looking south at representative wetland.



Photo 10 – From SW corner looking north at wetland along western boundary.



Photo 11 – From SW corner looking east along southern boundary and old barbed wire fence.



Photo 12 – From ~25 ft north of SW corner looking northeast along wetland and intermittent stream.



Photo 13 – From edge of wetland and hay field ~55 ft northeast of SW corner looking northeast across field at solitary white oak tree.



Photo 14 – Midway along southern boundary at gap in forested strip looking south into open field of adjacent conservation land.



Photo 15 – From ~20 feet south of large solitary oak tree looking northwest at intermittent stream drainage flowing toward wetland.



Photo 16 – From ~15 ft east of SE corner looking west at corner, southern boundary and representative mixed forest.



Photo 17 – From ~ 40 ft northeast of SE corner looking north along eastern boundary where forest meets open field.



Photo 18 – From edge of field on eastern boundary ~180 ft north of photopoint 17 looking west across open field.



Photo 19 – Looking south across open field at scenic viewshed from near the NE corner where field borders into scrub-shrub wetland and forest.
